From the Pastor's Desk

My good friends,

As Father's Day approaches, I would like to thank you ALL before hand for the love and generosity you always show to us, your 'Blessed Sacrament Fathers'... LOL!

Seriously, we are blest to have laity who are always there for us. When Father Cyprian visited last month, and now for this month it's Father Rafael (picture on page 1) the community sends food and gifts and invitations for visits and travel and much more. God bless all of you.

Someone even brings us the newspapers in English. John brings us the Post (once he's finished with it!) and Marty leaves us his paper. But someone very generously leaves the Daily News at our doorstep. First, I would love to know who you are so we can thank you. But second, I need to ask you to please stop buying that paper for us.

The Daily News is on a mission to take down the Roman Catholic Church. They are using the lifting of the statutes of limitations as an excuse to say that the Catholic Church is still protecting pedophile priests. 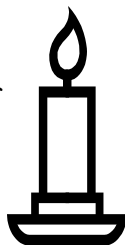
